SECTION 21 FIREARMS ACT

Section 21 of the Firearms Act prohibits persons possessing firearms, **including air guns**, if they have served a custodial sentence. The Club is required to obtain a declaration from prospective members that they are not so prohibited.

Section 21 applies to anybody who has been sentenced to a term of imprisonment, or to youth custody, or detention in a young offender institution, for three months or more.

The Act specifies a period of prohibition on such persons during which time it is an offence for them to have a firearm or ammunition in their possession at any time. The period for which they are prohibited depends on the length of the sentence:

If the sentence was longer than three years, the prohibition is for life

If the sentence was for three months or more, but less than three years, the prohibition lasts for five years from the date of release.

It is an offence for a person to transfer, let on hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone whom they know, or have reasonable grounds for believing, to be prohibited by section 21.

DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

The data given in this application form will be held by The Club as a data controller for the purpose of maintaining its register of members and accounts. The Club will have to supply this information to the Police, Home Office or other bodies authorised to receive it. By paying your subscription you are giving consent for The Club to keep and use information about you. The Club Chairman is the Club's representative under the Act. Membership records will be kept for a minimum of six years.

List of members and their details will not be made available to any party other than those mentioned above.

Notes

1. All application forms have to be sent to the Police.

2. All new applications are to be accompanied by photographic proof of identification (passport or photo driving license, a photocopy of either). If the applicant has no photographic proof of identification, then their sponsor is to sign the back of a passport size photograph annotating that "I certify this to be a true likeness of (Name of the applicant)". In addition to the photograph we will also need proof of residence in the form of a utility bill not more than 3 months old. These are to be kept in the Club in a locked filing cabinet in the armoury for Police inspection as and when required (after purchase of said cabinets).

3. The new applicants will only be allowed to sign up for 3 months in the first instance to allow for the probationary period. Once the Committee has ratified this then they will be entitled to sign up for any of the publicised periods.

4. Junior members who have no proof of identification will need their accompanying adult to sign the photo as a true likeness.
